

CONCERNED RESIDENTS MEETING (17 Feb 2020 at 18h30)

▪ Residents Meeting attendance

- **ALL** residents are urged to please participate in residential meetings. We cannot make a difference if we are lacking

▪ Service Delivery

1. Calls must be logged with City Jo'burg various entities if we want to action and resolve Elands Park issues
2. Any tickets logged with regards to area maintenance (City Power/Parks etc.) must be communicated on the relevant street WhatsApp group which will in turn be escalated to Faye to expedite resolution
3. Residents are urged to log calls for the following:
 - a. Tall grass around the area with City Parks
 - b. Streetlights (referencing pole numbers) with City Power
4. All reference numbers of calls being logged and that have been logged but not resolved, are to be sent to the WhatsApp group Admin of street groups for collation before Thursday. This will be escalated to Faye at Fibre meeting

▪ Residents Responsibility

1. Report people from our area that are urinating and defecating in our area
2. Report public sex especially in Millin Str. These are being monitored by camera from now on.
3. Report stray dogs that should be behind closed gates to the SPCA
4. Don't tolerate littering in ElandsPark. Request progress on the promise from City Parks to strategically place bins around the area in the last residential meeting held
5. ***Ensure that all residents are added to relative Street Groups***
6. ***Residents are asked to start donating from as little as R50 per month to start booming off ElandsPark. Banking details have been and will be shared. All paying residents are recorded and will be handed a sticker to identify when accessing the area once boomed off. Residents that are either unemployed or pensioners can assist by offering their time/talents***

▪ Security Companies

1. Residents that pay a certain security company must ask that company to patrol and be more visible in the area
2. South End will only be tending to calls logged by paying customers going forward

▪ Patrolling Group

1. More participation and visibility needed
2. Suggestion: to compile a patrol schedule
3. Suggestion to start athletic club – walking and cycling while patrolling
4. The “church” on the field (Watermeyer Rd) has been addressed and must be closely monitored
5. Hawking on Eugene Marais opposite the shop to be monitored
6. Shacks on N17 – patrol to be planned by men involved. Participation from all concerned residents are welcome
7. Awareness group to be created for Power outages

- **Partitions required to and to be driven by the Elandspark Residents Association**
 1. No more taxis passing or parking in our area
 2. To put speed bumps in Watermeyer Rd
 3. Fence off the field between Heidelberg Rd and Watermeyer Rd and use it as a recreational area for children to enjoy
